In the breathtaking wellness suite, you'll find a fitness studio, spa and sauna, all nestled alongside a 10.2-metre swimming pool.



On the upper floors, you'll find six sumptuous bedrooms, a handsome leather-panelled study, and, of course, the sprawling roof terrace. This cavernous home just might have everything you need – but you can also pop in to The Garrison Club, Chelsea Barracks' on-site members' club, which just happens to be kitted out with everything from a sports hall and spa treatment rooms to a billiards room, boardroom, and residents' lounge. You'd be hard pressed to find anything more luxurious.
